Below is a partial list of the duties & responsibilities of the Office of Operations & Projects:

- Conduct internal evaluation of programs & operations to identify areas of improvement & cost savings
- Facilitate internal coordination between Departments & Offices on projects, grants & shared services
- Evaluate GIS & other technological tools to improve efficiency, inventory tracking & service
- Create a centralized records management system to improve records retrieval & reduce duplication & storage demands
- Identify additional grant or service sharing opportunities
- Acquire & track Stimulus Funding programs
- Identify & implement "Green Solutions" to reduce costs, reduce impacts on the environment & improve efficient use of resources
- Review, respond & implement suggestions received through the Continuing Improvement website, both internal & external
- Coordinate preparation of the SWFWMD Cooperative Funding Grant Program
- Serve as liaison to Progress Energy Florida on plant upgrades, retrofits & new projects
- Serve as liaison to State & federal agencies on updating their Management Plans
- Assist in development of a regional solution for solid waste collection, recycling & disposal
- Assist in public education & public input on proposed regulations, projects or program revisions
- Coordinate preparation of a Disaster Recovery Plan
