We are honored to have **Debbe Hooper, Citrus County Water Resources Conservation Specialist**, as our guest speaker.

The meeting will be held on **Wednesday, August 25, 2010 from 6:30 PM to 8:00 PM** at the **Sugarmill Woods Country Club**.

**Do you want to know where your water supply comes from?
Come on an exciting journey through the aquifer**

Debbe will give a short introductory presentation entitled "**Know Where It Flows**", which addresses some facts on what are the various water sources, what we need to do to protect them, and helpful tips on what we can all do to save water and money.

Debbe will then host a fantastic film entitled "**Water's Journey, The Hidden Rivers of Florida**". It is a documentary created by famed underwater photographer Wes Skiles about a journey through the Florida Aquifer. It is filmed in north Florida. Two divers follow the path of the water underground for ten miles and two scientists track them above ground. The photography is outstanding. Karst Productions whose web site can be found at www.karstproductions.com is the creator of the film. The following is an Introduction to the film:

"Over 8 billion gallons of water a day burst forth from Florida's springs....the most unique concentration of springs on the planet. At one time it was thought to be an endless supply, but now the demands of man are starting to exceed availability. Join a team on a daring journey into the Floridian Aquifer to find out what's going wrong. They follow the connective path of water through the landscape. Their discoveries lead you on a thrilling adventure about the miraculous course that the water takes."

We will follow the film with a brief question and answer period.
