FY2010 Water Smart Rebate Program

Citrus County Utilities is offering its customers a series of rebate incentives to promote water conservation.

AVAILABLE REPLACEMENT REBATES

- High Efficiency and Ultra Low Flow Toilets [Complete Units*] - up to \$100 (not to exceed cost of toilet)
- High Efficiency Clothes Washers** - up to \$100 (not to exceed cost of washer)
- Weather Based Irrigation Controller - up to \$100 (not to exceed cost of controller)
- Rain or Moisture Sensor - up to \$ 50 (not to exceed cost of sensor)
- Tankless Water Heaters - up to \$100 (not to exceed cost of heater)
- Dishwashers - up to \$100 (not to exceed cost of dishwasher)

TO QUALIFY

- Water efficient equipment must be installed on a property that receives water and/or sewer service from the Citrus County Utilities.
- Equipment must be purchased before 05/01/10. Installations must be completed by 06/01/2010.
- Participant agrees to an installation verification visit.
- Participant agrees to complete a post-installation survey.
- If later relocating, participant agrees not to relocate qualifying equipment.

RESTRICTIONS APPLY

- There is a limit of: two (2) toilets per property; one (1) washer; one (1) WB irrigation controller; one (1) rain or moisture sensor; one (1) tankless water heater; and one (1) dishwasher.
- Amount of the rebate is not to exceed price of purchased device.
- Rebates do not include sales tax, installation costs, delivery charges and other material costs.
- Newly built homes (constructed after 12/31/2004) are not eligible toilet and rain sensor rebates.
- Toilets must be a complete unit: they can be one piece (tank and bowl as one unit) or two pieces (tank and bowl) to be fitted together for a complete unit. Rebate also applies to dual flush toilets, ultra low flow urinals and waterless urinals.
