Sugarmill Woods Residential Recycling

I received another update from F.D.S. Disposal with the collection results for the month of March for residential pick up of recyclables. We have now recycled **62 tons (124,000 pounds)** in the first month. Another point of interest is Yard Waste collection. In February, 2010 prior to the bundled program offering, F.D.S. Disposal collected **16.6 tons (33,200 pounds)** of yard waste. For the month of March, 2010, the Yard Waste collection has jumped to **44.2 tons (88,400 pounds)**. Many more residents are using this service and helping to preserve the beauty of our greenbelt. More information and related articles will be appearing in the April issue of the Greenbelt Gazette.
