**Citrus 20/20** is a broad-based nonprofit community organization with a mission of being the catalyst to help Citrus County create and implement a vision of the community. The origin of Citrus 20/20 started in 1995 with a broad cross-section of Citrus County residents who gathered to answer the question of what kind of community we want to be in 25 years and then develop a Vision for Citrus County. The target date for realization of this vision was the year 2020.

Out of the original visioning process, issues critical to the county's development were identified and a comprehensive vision for the community was created. Implementation of the original vision was tracked with a follow-up in 1996 and again 1999 with an audit of the original action plans.

Since the original visioning process, a report has been made annually to the Citrus County Board of County Commissioners on progress toward achievement of the vision.

**Citrus 20/20** is working with local organizations to sponsor a **"Vision Check 2010"** to update the Vision Statement for Citrus County, report on progress to date, and identify new action plans that should be implemented to achieve the Vision for 2020. Resident participation and input is encouraged on a variety of topics affecting all of us who live, work, play, and pay taxes in Citrus County.
