Title:	Cutting Your Water Bill	
Description:	Efficient indoor water usage is estimated at 45 gallons per person per day (or 1,350 gallons per person per month). You are essentially "flushing money down the toilet" if your indoor water use is more than this amount per person. Learn about simple upgrades and changes that can help you to cut water waste indoors and outdoors, reducing your water bill. Two sessions will be offered: 4 - 5 p.m. and 6 - 7 p.m. The class will be held at the Central Ridge Library, 425 W. Roosevelt Boulevard, Beverly Hills.
