Dear Residents,

As many of you know, **Unites States Marine Cpl. Johnathan W. Taylor**, 23, a Citrus County and Sugarmill Woods resident, was killed in Helmand Province, Afghanistan on February 22, 2011. Cpl. Taylor heads home today to a community eager to show its respect for the fallen Marine.

Cpl. Taylor's body is scheduled to arrive at 1 PM at Hernando County Airport in Brooksville from Dover Air Force Base in Delaware. Citrus County Sheriff's officers will escort Cpl. Taylor's family and the hearse to Wilder Funeral Home in Homosassa. The procession will pass through Floral City (US 41), Inverness (SR 44), Lecanto (CR 490), and Homosassa (US 19). It is expected to be in Inverness at about 2:15 PM according to the Citrus County Chronicle.

A public Memorial Service is scheduled for 10 AM Saturday, March 5 at Lecanto High School, where Cpl. Taylor graduated in 2006. The service will be held in the Stadium.

I have been informed that All Veteran's Service Organizations are encouraged to have representatives attend, in uniform. Military Organizations such as Civil Air Patrol, Sea Cadets, Young Marines, and JROTC Units are also encouraged to attend, in uniform. Seating for these groups will be on the field.
