**Dear Residents,**

I have a few updates that I wanted to bring to your attention.

### **Irrigation Control Timers - Daylight Saving Time Change**

This is a reminder that **Daylight Saving Time begins on Sunday March 13, 2011**. Please remember to change your Irrigation Control Timer as well as your other clocks. The Citrus County Department of Water Resources has been patrolling Sugarmill Woods heavily for the last few weeks and is continuing to do so. Please change the time on your Irrigation Control Timer Sunday morning to avoid a potential fine for watering outside the allowed times.

Many residents are repairing or replacing damaged lawns. If you are installing or recently installed new sod, different watering rules may apply for a short period of time after the installation. You need to notify the Water Resources Department when you install new sod, where it is installed, provide a dated receipt of the purchase or work performed, etc. if you want to take advantage of the relaxed watering restrictions while the new sod gets established. If you don't report it and you are watering outside the normal restricted times for odd and even addresses, you may be cited and fined for illegal watering. Please notify the Water Resources Department ahead of time and avoid the frustration for you and the county officials. Your cooperation would be appreciated.

### **Distribution of Sugarmill Woods Phonebook**

Finally, the Sugarmill Woods Phonebooks have arrived from the Printer / Binder. We have experienced several delays this year related to finalizing the copy and the distribution of the Sugarmill Woods Phonebooks to residents. Some of the advertisers were slow returning their proofs to the publisher / printer. Some of the other communities had trouble meeting their original deadlines. The publisher creates phonebooks similar to ours for three other communities and schedules the printing & distribution for all of them at the same time. The good news is that we were able to incorporate several change requests received from residents in February. The mailing of the 2011 SMW Phonebook is now scheduled to begin next week. We apologize for this delay and appreciate your understanding.

### **FDS Updates on Recycling**

F.D.S. Disposal, Inc. is now accepting ALL PET / Plastic containers with the symbol #1; HDPE / natural plastic containers with the symbol # 2 (milk, juice, water bottles, etc.); HDPE / pigmented plastic containers with symbol # 2 (detergent, shampoo, bleach, etc.); and Plastics with the symbol #3, #4, #5, #6, #7. Before only narrow neck containers were accepted.

**Hazardous Materials containers** of any type; including empty oil containers, pesticide containers, pool chemical containers, paint containers, etc **ARE NOT accepted** for recycling. Please place these empty containers in with your regular garbage.

F.D.S. Disposal, Inc announced they will resume distributing the Blue Wheeled Recycling Totes sometime in April to their customers who are residents in Cypress Village. The totes are on order now and FDS is expecting delivery late March / early April. Customers will be notified of the pending delivery dates.
