Dear Residents,

This is a **Special Advisory** to everyone if you have **Recreational Vehicles (RVs), Boats, or other recreational equipment stored at the Cypress Village Center Storage area**. One of our residents alerted me that they found their RV had been broken into. They checked their friend's RV there and found that it too had been broken into.

This resident called Citrus Management and told them about the burglary. Citrus Management told them that it was the first time that they (Citrus Management) had heard of it. The resident also reported it to the Sheriff's Office. While the resident was at the Cypress Village Center Storage area with the Sheriff's Office Investigative representative, they noticed **two other RVs with windows open and / or broken**. The Sheriff's Deputy agreed to check into those two as well. This means there were at least four vehicles with damage and possible illegal entry.

When I viewed the Crime Mapping On Line Report, **Case number 11040864 had been opened on April 22, 2011 at 6:45 PM for a VEHICLE BREAK-IN / THEFT (Burglary - Conveyance - Unoccupied) for this incident.**

If you own any recreational vehicles, boats, or other recreational equipment stored in the Cypress Village Center storage area, please check it out immediately for any damage or vandalism that might have occurred recently. If you find any damage or vandalism, please contact the Sheriff's Office and report it immediately. Contact numbers are:
