### **Community Outreach Program Meetings**

**Wednesday, June 1, 2011 - Citrus County Emergency Operations Center Assistant Director, Robert Wesch**, is the guest speaker from **6:30 PM to 7:45 PM at the Sugarmill Woods Country Club**. He will address Hurricane Preparedness among other things to help get us prepared in case a disaster strikes. **Gerry Brummer, Chairman of the Southwest Quadrant (Sugarmill Woods) Community Emergency Response Team (CERT)** will also be there to give a brief talk about their volunteer organization, what they do to help us in time of emergencies, and how you can help.

**Tuesday, June 7, 2011 - Unites States Congressman Rich Nugent** is our guest speaker from **6:30 PM to 7:45 PM at the Sugarmill Woods Country Club**. Congressman Nugent represents the Fifth District of Florida which includes Citrus, Hernando, Lake, Levy, Marion, Pasco, Polk, and Sumter Counties. Last month, he held budget listening sessions at several locations in his district regarding our impending budget crisis and proposed responses to the crisis. We received feedback from residents that they were not able to attend any of those sessions and asked if we could possibly request him to come to Sugarmill Woods. Congressman Nugent has graciously accepted our invitation to meet with residents here in Sugarmill Woods.

We have asked Congressman Nugent to share with us his experiences as our new representative in Congress and to discuss various issues that are affecting "all of us" in some way. Some of the hot topics are the economy and the road to recovery, the Paul Ryan proposal for reducing deficit spending and the National Debt, tax revenue opportunities, possible Medicare and Medicaid impacts, what is happening with the recently enacted Healthcare legislation, and many more. Many people believe that we need a combination of significant expense cutting in some areas and potential tax increases in other areas to resolve the many issues facing our country.
