

# **Sugarmill Woods Bulletin**

**Dear Residents,**

We are going to hold another "**SMW Bike Lanes Proposal**" **Open House** for those residents who were not able to attend the October 13 afternoon session for whatever reason. The session format and content will be identical to the first session but it will be held during early evening hours instead. It is open to all residents. Like the first session, the Sugarmill Woods Civic Association together with Citrus County Public Works / Engineering, Cypress Village POA and Oak Village Association will be jointly hosting an Open House session for all residents to review a proposal to add bike lanes to selected Boulevard roads within the Sugarmill Woods community.

### **SMW Bike Lanes Proposal Open House**

#### **Tuesday, November 1, 2011**

#### **5:30 PM to 7:30 PM**

#### **Sugarmill Woods Country Club**

The format will be an Open House session where residents are invited to come anytime between the hours of 5:30 PM and 7:30 PM to meet with County, Civic Association, and POA representatives to review the details of this proposal. It will not be a sit down meeting. We will have detailed maps of the proposed routes, documents showing the end product, proposed schedules, what the proposed changes involve, comment forms, etc. Residents are encouraged to come to the session to meet with the various representatives, ask questions to get a complete understanding of the proposal, and provide their comments and feedback. A Comment Form is attached to this bulletin and will also be available at the Open meeting for residents to submit their written comments, suggestions, and position on the proposal.

The proposal is to add bike lanes to the following roads:

#### **PHASE 1**

- ✱ **Oak Park Blvd West (CR 480)** from the intersection at Corkwood Blvd to the rear (east) entrance to Shoppes at Sugarmill Woods.
- ✱ **Cypress Village Blvd East** from the intersection at Cypress Village Circle to the intersection at Oak Park Blvd West (CR 480).
- ✱ **Oak Village Blvd** from the intersection at Oak Park Blvd (CR 480) to the intersection at US Hwy 98.
- ✱ **Oak Village Blvd South** from the intersection at US Hwy 98 to the intersection at Poppy Street.
- ✱ **US Hwy 98 South Side** from the intersection at Oak Village Blvd South along US Hwy 98 to the Suncoast Parkway 1 Trailhead. (This segment will be a single ten foot wide bike path on the south side of US Hwy 98 on the outer edge of the road right of way.)

#### **PHASE 2**

- ✱ **Corkwood Blvd** from the intersection at Cypress Village Blvd East to the intersection at Oak Park Blvd West (CR 480).
- ✱ **Cypress Village Circle and Cypress Village Blvd West** from the intersection at Cypress Village Circle to the intersection at Douglas Street / US Hwy 19.
- ✱ **Greenpark Blvd** from the intersection at US Hwy 98 to the intersection at Oak Village Blvd South.
- ✱ **Glenridge Blvd** from the intersection at Corkwood Blvd to the end of Glenridge Blvd.

Please take this opportunity to learn about this proposal and provide your feedback. The SMW Civic Association together with Citrus County Engineering, Cypress Village POA, and Oak Village Association created a "Frequently Asked Q&As" document.
